Triple - D Practice Drill

Step by Step Instructions

- Step 1: Read for 1 minute (so that you can have a conversation about it with someone)
- Step 2: Note how much material you covered, and DOUBLE it. Place a mark at the goal so you'll know if you made it! Then go through everything in ONE minute!
- Step 3: DOUBLE again! Place another mark at the goal so you'll know if you made it! Then go through everything in ONE minute!
- Step 4: DOUBLE again! Place another mark at the goal so you'll know if you made it! Then go through everything in ONE minute!
- Step 5: Read for 1 minute (so that you can have a conversation about it with someone)
- Step 6: Based on what you read in Step 5, figure out your Word per Minute and record that number in your practice log.

Example:

- Step 1: Bob reads (using a pointer) for 1 minute.
- Step 2: Bob looks at how much he just read and figures it to be about 1/2 page. He then adds another 1/2 page and places a mark there. He goes through that in 1 minute.
- Step 3: Now that Bob has gone through 1 full page, he adds another full page. He places his mark at the 2 page goal and goes through everything in a minute.
- Step 4: Bob just went through 2 full pages. So he adds another 2! He places his mark at the 4 page mark and goes through all 4 pages in a minute! (Yeah... total blur!)
- Step 5: Bob then reads for 1 minute (so he can actually have a conversation about what he read).
- Step 6: Bob figures out his reading speed (WPM) and records it on his practice log!
